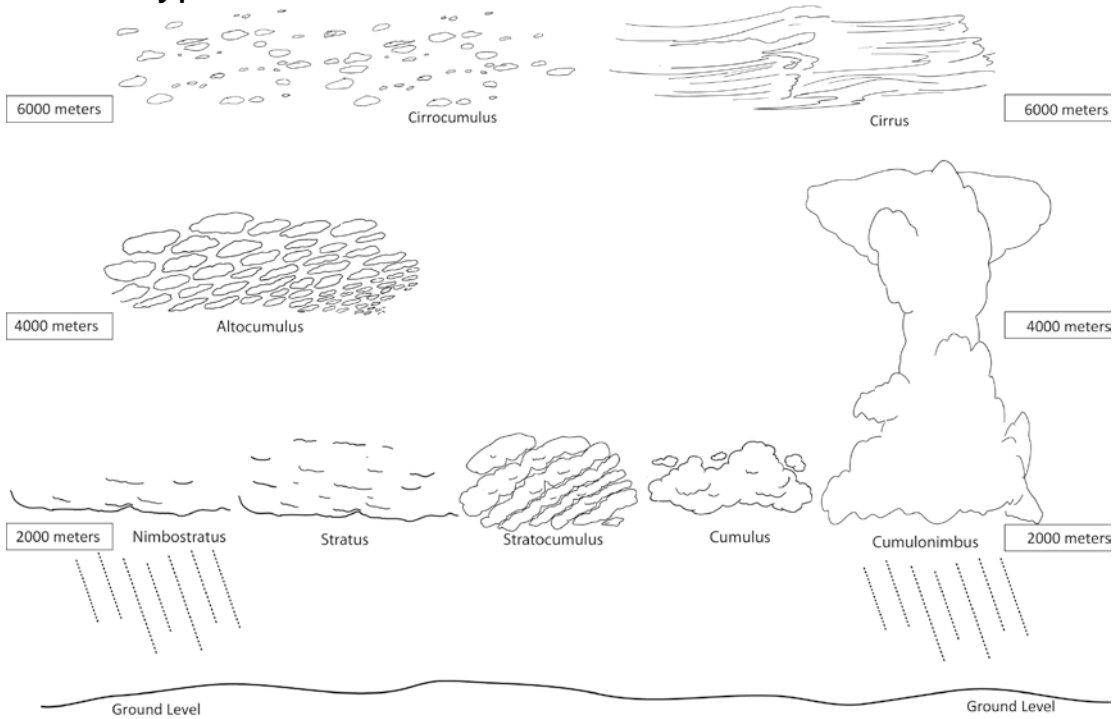


Cloud Types

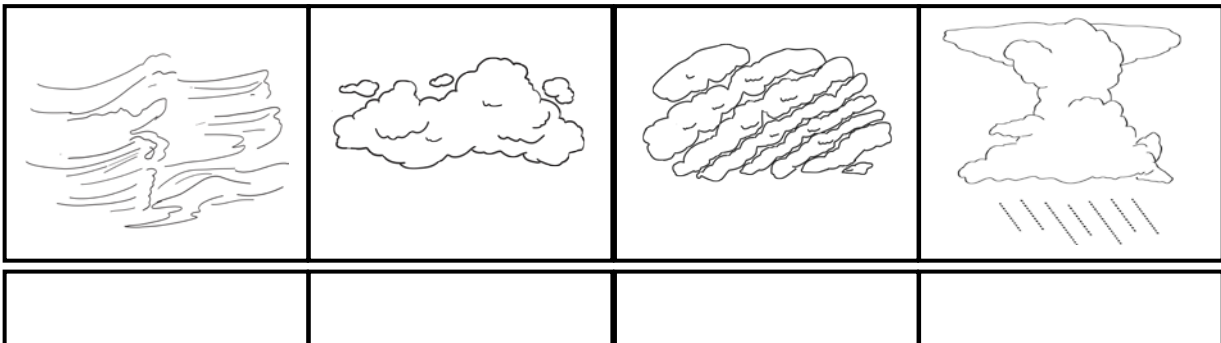
